RM of Tache Lorette Community Complex RETURN TO PLAY PROTOCOL

CREATED JULY 28TH, 2020 UPDATED September 7, 2021

The Rural Municipality of Tache is committed to ensuring the health and safety of our user groups and staff. The facility will only be accessible to participants of pre-arranged bookings and appointments.

Masks are mandatory for everyone entering the arena except for participants on the ice.

MAIN USER GROUPS

Lorette Minor Hockey, Seine River Skating Club and Lorette Ringette are required to have all participants including coaches, instructors and managers complete and sign the following documents and supply a copy to the Lorette facility manager:

- Declaration of Compliance COVID-19
- Release of Liability, Waiver of Claims and Indemnity Agreement
- Informed Consent and Assumption of Risk Agreement (for minors)

These forms must include the naming of the RM of Tache to be released and indemnified of any claims against it as well as the respective club (user group). This information will not be released to others unless required by law and will be destroyed 3 weeks after season ending.

Each user groups governing body's Covid-19 protocol shall be followed in addition to this facility protocol. When protocols are conflicting then the more restrictive one will prevail.

FACILITY MAINTENANCE & SANITIZATION

New protocols and procedures are in place to prevent the spread of COVID-19. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Restricted facility access
 - Those 18 years and older must produce proof of full immunization and ID to enter the facility. (MB immunization card, electronic QR code, Shared Health immunization record or other provincially approved medium)
 Youth (17 years and younger) engaged in youth sport are exempt
- Ensuring signage to educate patrons of physical distancing and hand hygiene
- Providing hand sanitizer throughout the facility
- Increased frequency of cleaning in washrooms and high traffic areas

- Sanitization of all benches between groups
- Increased supervision; and
- An air purifying unit installed in lower level

PHYSICAL DISTANCING & HAND SANITIZING

All employees and users are recommended to continue to physical distance by standing and sitting at least two meters away from other people throughout the facility. Distancing markers, chairs and signage will be placed throughout the facility indicating proper distancing.

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the facility. Dispensers are located at entrance and exit points, as well as high traffic areas and high-risk areas. When entering the facility all patrons are required to utilize the hand sanitizer.

ARRIVAL/DROP OFF

The facility may be entered via main entrance only. When entering, individuals will be required to hand sanitize. A staff member will verify proof of immunization (for those affected) and will direct the individuals to their designated area while physically distancing.

Exit from the building will be the east side extending benches through the emergency exit for the first user group and for the second user group it will be through the canteen lobby west side doors only to avoid any contact between arriving and exiting groups.

Access to the facility is limited to fifteen minutes before and after the scheduled ice time. Failure to vacate the building within the fifteen minutes time limit will result in delays for the following users and an additional arena facility rate charge will result.

All users are strongly encouraged to arrive fully dressed except helmets and skates.

GENERAL RULES

- Masks are mandatory for everyone entering the arena, with the exception of players on the ice.
- Ice capacity is per current Manitoba Health guidelines or the guidelines required by the recreation governing body. When requirements are conflicting the most restrictive will apply at the time of ice rental.
- Showers are closed.
- The dressing rooms are available for one team at a time only per booking and are sanitized after each team before the next team can enter the basement dressing rooms.
- User groups are responsible for sanitizing any shared equipment between uses.
- Absolutely no spitting or fighting at any time.

- All users must bring their own labeled, pre-filled water bottle. Sharing of water bottles is prohibited and no water fountains are available for participants or spectators.
- Its recommended that all players and coaches must maintain physical distancing while in the facility.
- This protocol is subject to change at any time. Please note that at any time this facility may be temporarily closed or access restricted if required by public health order.

Not following the rules as laid outlined by the Lorette Arena or as required by the recreation governing body may lead to the eviction from the premises.
